Key Knowledge:


- Caroline Parrot is British artist who uses different textures and pattern to create animals.
- Marks can be made with a range of materials.
- Lines can be used to make shapes.
- Understand that colours can be mixed to make new colours.
- Mix colours to match images or objects they have observed.
- Patterns can be created in paint by adding textures such as wax, sand or salt.
- Pencils can be used to create different effects, e.g. Dark and light lines and shading

Personal Social and Emotional Development (PSCHE): Friendship

Using our No Outsiders text, *The Blue Chameleon*, we will be thinking about what it is to be a good friend and how it is ok to be different to our friends.

People, Cultures and Communities (Geography): Comparing UK and Polar Region and Chinese New Year

Key Knowledge:

- The weather is hotter in some countries and colder in others.
- There are different animals in other countries.
- Some animals like hot weather and some like cold weather.
- Natural features are things that haven't been made people - ocean, river, woodland
- Man-made features are things that people have made. - buildings
- Buildings look different in other countries.
- People eat different food in other countries
- People wear different clothes in other countries.

People, Cultures and Communities (Geography): Buddhism and Ramadan (Friendships)

In RE, we will learn about Buddhism. In our guided reading sessions, we will be learning about the Muslim festival of Ramadan.

Key Knowledge:

- Buddhists believe in their God, called Buddha.
- Buddhists celebrate Buddha's birthday by lighting lanterns, singing and releasing caged animals.
- Buddhists believe that the lotus flower brings them luck and money.
- Some statues of Buddha have long hair because Buddha cut off his hair when he left the palace.
- Some statues of Buddha have long ears to show that Buddha always listens.
